

Course Information

Day courses commence at 10.00am until 3.00pm, with a one-hour break for lunch. A 50% deposit is required when booking a course.

Cancellations less than 4 weeks prior to the date booked, the deposit is forfeited. Fee balance is payable on the day. Each course will be supplied with all materials necessary for the individual project. Students will be expected to supply a sharp pair of scissors and the appropriate embroidery hoop, indicated on each course. Coffee/ tea will be included in the fee. Refreshments can be purchased from Mary's Tearoom in the lunchtime break.

All courses use our own designs, which may be viewed, in the Exhibition area, at the Needlework Centre.

Main door will be open 15 minutes prior to class commencing.

PRIVATE COURSES FOR ORGANISED GROUPS

For individual organisations wishing to have a private class at the Mary Jane Studio, the minimum number of students required is 12.

Tutors can be supplied to organisations that have their own venue, with the minimum number of 12 students. There would be no extra charge to the course fee up to a 20-mile radius of the studio. Travelling further than 20 miles, expenses would be negotiated.

The course fee includes 4-hour tuition and all materials to complete the project.

Students must supply sharp scissors & embroidery hoop.

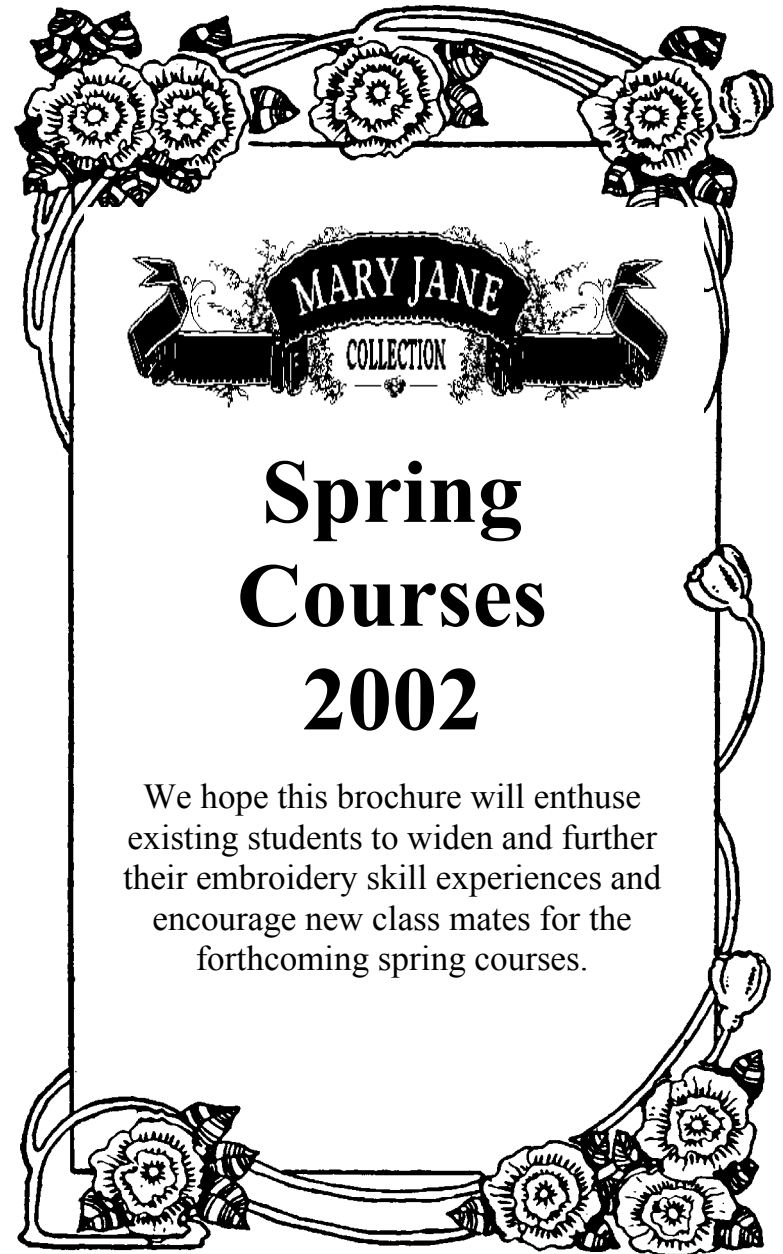
